Our website uses cookies to distinguish you from other users of our website. This helps us to provide you with a good experience when you browse our website and also allows us to improve our site.

What is a cookie?

A cookie is a small file of letters and numbers that we store on your browser or the hard drive of your computer if you agree. Cookies contain information that is transferred to your computer's hard drive. We use the categorisation set out by the International Chamber of Commerce in their [UK Cookie Guide](#).

What cookies do we use?

We use three categories of cookies:

- **Strictly necessary cookies.** These are cookies that are required for the operation of our website. They include, for example, cookies that enable you to log into secure areas of our website, use a shopping cart or make use of e-billing services.
- **Analytical or performance cookies.** These allow us to recognise and count the number of visitors and to see how visitors move around our website when they are using it. This helps us to improve the way our website works, for example, by ensuring that users are finding what they are looking for easily.

ssr-caching	Strictly Necessary	Used to indicate the system from which the site was rendered.	1 minute
XSRF-TOKEN	Strictly Necessary	Ensures visitor browsing security by preventing cross-site request forgery. This cookie is essential for the security of the website and the visitor.	Session
_ga	Analytics	Google Analytics - registers a unique ID that is used to generate statistical data on how the visitor uses the website.	2 years
svSession	Strictly Necessary	Identifies unique visitors and tracks a visitor's sessions on a site.	1 year
hs	Strictly Necessary	Ensures visitor browsing security by preventing cross-site request forgery. This cookie is essential for the security of the website and the visitor.	Session
_gid	Analytics	Google Analytics - registers a unique ID that is used to generate statistical data on how the visitor uses the website.	1 day
bSession	Strictly Necessary	Registers which server-cluster is serving the visitor. This is used in context with load balancing, in order to optimise user experience.	30 minutes
gat*****	Analytics	Google Analytics - used to control the request rate	1 minute
ASWALB	Strictly Necessary	Registers which server cluster serves the visitor, used in conjunction with load balancing to optimise user experience	7 days
AWSALBCORS	Strictly Necessary	Required for load balancing service and ensures that a single user is assigned to a single website host	6 days
_wix_browser_session	Strictly Necessary	Wix technical cookies that disappear at the end of a session, used for system monitoring/ debugging	Session
_wixCIDX	Strictly Necessary	Used for system monitoring/ debugging.	Session

consent-policy	Strictly Necessary	Used for Cookie Banner perimeters.	1 year

More on Google Analytics

As noted in the table above, our website currently uses **Google Analytics**, a web analytics service provided by Google, Inc. (“Google”). Google Analytics uses “cookies”, which (as discussed above) are text files placed on your computer, to help the website analyse how users use the site. The information generated by the cookie about your use of the website (including your IP address) will be transmitted to and stored by Google on servers in the United States. Google will use this information for the purpose of evaluating your use of the website, compiling reports on website activity for website operators and providing other services relating to website activity and internet usage.

Google may also transfer this information to third parties where required to do so by law, or where such third parties process the information on Google's behalf. Google will not associate your IP address with any other data held by Google. You may refuse the use of cookies by selecting the appropriate settings on your browser, however please note that if you do this you may not be able to use the full functionality of this website. By using this website, you consent to the processing of data about you by Google in the manner and for the purposes set out above. For more details, please read **Google’s Analytics overview**.

Can I block cookies?

You can block cookies by activating the setting on your browser that allows you to refuse the setting of all or some cookies.
